4. Hays Recruitment Partnership Proposal

FH introduced Hazel Baxter from Hays Recruitment and thanked her for sponsoring the lunch at the meeting.

Hazel Baxter gave a presentation on the services provided by Hays Recruitment and gave out a handout which gave her contact details for anyone that maybe interested in the service they provide. The cost of the service they provide is bespoke to each school but does become cheaper if schools go in collectively.

5. Philosophy for children

Gillian Andrews gave a detailed outline of the Philosophy for Children project and reported that she is now trained at Level 3 so is able to do in-house training herself to Southend schools. GA introduced Julie Batchelor and 9 pupils (Year 4&5) from Earls Hall Junior School who came along to give a presentation about their experiences of P4C in their own words.

At the end of the presentation the children were happy to answer questions.

GA thanked JB and the children for the presentation. GA also described a new development where year 12/13 students are able to apply for the 2 day Level 1 P4C accredited training. 20 students are currently enrolled from Belfairs and Southend High School for Boys. The year 12/13 students once trained, will be able to lead philosophy sessions in their own or Primary schools. GA is also keen to develop programmes for parents and asked anyone interested to contact her.

Frances Neil and Lisa Clark gave an overview of the EAL project and explained that there is a continued problem with getting data from the LA They asked if anyone would have any objection if they arranged to collect anonymous data from schools directly.
